Transforming Schools through Restorative Justice Practices

Restorative Justice Practices (RJP) begin with understanding that the intentional building of respectful relationships is the foundation of all things restorative. RJP is an indigenous based philosophy that is being rediscovered and implemented in schools across the nation. The framework of RJP builds and sustains a climate where relationships, respect, responsibility and equity are at the core of a nurturing, welcoming and inclusive school community leveraging the desire to repair relationships when harm has occurred.

When RJP is woven throughout the fabric of an entire school community, respectful relationships are built and sustained. This requires the ability to embrace diversity and work collaboratively with all stakeholders.

With the dynamic Museum of Tolerance as a backdrop, this two-day interactive training will provide participants with:

- The understanding of TJP and its relationship to social justice
- Practical RJP applications to integrate inside and outside classroom settings
- Strategies to integrate RJP with all school community stakeholders
- Core skills to facilitate Community Building Circles and Healing Circles
